COURSE GOALS:

1. Students will identify the elements of literature through readings in and out of class (i.e., character, setting, plot, climax, mood, and point of view).

- 2. Students will examine epic poetry and Shakespearean drama to identify the literary elements present.
- 3. Students will analyze and reproduce poetry with regard to imagery, sound devices, and author's purpose.
- 4. Students will create and evaluate fiction and nonfiction works to enhance their writing ability.
- 5. Students will utilize vocabulary found in texts covered.
- 6. Students will identify the appropriate word choice in writing.
- 7. Students will employ appropriate punctuation in sentences used for paragraphs and essays.
- 8. Students will be able to write, revise, and edit for clarity in all writing assignments.

COURSE CONTENT:

- 1. Grammar lessons: appropriate word choice, appropriate use of punctuation (end marks, commas, semi-colons, quotations, apostrophes, etc.), and sentence fragments.
- 2. Characterization, conflict, setting, and theme in short stories
- 3. Examples of genres in literature including poetry, drama, nonfiction, fiction, etc.
- 4. MLA formatting
- 5. Persuasion in writing and how it is used
- 6. Shakespearean drama
- 7. Short stories and novels
