Changes:

Led by St. Vincent Youth Ministry and not associated with VMY

Traditionally, this trip has been led by Vincentian Marian Youth or VMY for our area. We gladly welcome all of those from outside of Perry County to still join our group who would usually go with VMY. Alex Hermann will be the Group Leader

Monies can come from your VMY account

If you have money in an account with VMY, it can be used the pay the fees for this year's March. That needs to be indicated on your St. Vincent Liability Form and again later on the Final Payment Letter.

We are travelling with "Generation Life" or "Gen Life"

This year we are joining forces with the Archdiocese of St. Louis. The name of their group is "Generation Life" or "Gen Life". This offers us some very exciting new opportunities!

- We will be joining over 2000 other participants from the St. Louis area
- We will stay in a hotel with all the "Gen Life" group
- We will attend nightly conferences with the "Gen Life" group
- Conferences include Pro-Life speakers, a band, and access to the sacraments
- We will attend a "Gen Life" Mass on the morning of the March with Archbishop Carlson
- We will tour on our own on Saturday
- There is an optional Students for Life leadership Conference on Saturday if you are willing to sacrifice touring
- We will end our trip with a "Gen Life" group Mass at the National Basilica

Rooming

Chaperone Limits
