WHEN: January 17th-21st, 2018

Jan. 17th: Depart from satellite locations across the Archdiocese of St. Louis in the evening. Perryville Location will be the Shrine Church. Time: tbd

Jan. 18th: Arrive in Washington DC and check into the hotel. Evening programming held in the hotel

Jan. 19th: Morning Mass followed by the March on Washington with evening programming at the hotel

Jan. 20th: Touring day or attendance of Students for Life Conference concluding with a vigil Mass at the National Shrine and departure home

Jan. 21st: Arrive in St. Louis at various return locations in the afternoon

WHO: High School Teens, Young Adults, and Adults

All High School students and Young Adults (18-20) are welcome

Chaperone* Ratios:

-Up to **one adult** per every **four teens** and must have at least **one adult** for every **eight teens**.

*All Chaperones must be 21 or older and in compliance with Archdiocesan Youth Ministry Policies.

COST: \$275.00 per person (not including food/souvenir)

Quad: \$275.00, 4 to 5 people to a hotel room

Triple: \$300.00, 3 people to a hotel room

Double: \$365.00, 2 people to a hotel room

Single: \$475.00, 1 person to a hotel room

*Singles and Doubles are available on a limited, first come first served basis. Quads and Triples have priority to hotel rooms with two double beds. Paying the "Double Rate" does not guarantee 2 beds in a room.

Registration Information

Group Registration

The first step in registration is to register your school or church as a "Group" on October 12th, 2017 at 10:00am.

-A "Group" consists of one of the following two options:

- Only 8th Graders (The entire group would attend the 8th Grade Track)
- Only High School Teens (The entire group would attend the High School Track)

**If both an 8th grade and high school group will be attending from your parish, they will need to be registered as two separate groups, each with a designated group leader.

You will need the following information to register your Group:

For an 8th Grade Group:

- Group Name
- Group Leader name
- Group Leader e-mail and cell phone number
- Diocese and Address
- Number of 8th grade participants
- Number of Young Adults* attending the 8th Grade Track
- Number of Chaperones
- Number of Priests

For a High School Group:

- Group Name
- Group Leader name
- Group Leader e-mail and cell phone number
- Diocese and Address
- Number of High School Teen participants
- Number of Young Adults* attending the High School Track
- Number of Chaperones
- Number of Priests

*Young adults who attend with either an 8th grade or high school group will have a ministerial role. They must be between the ages of 18 and 21 and be in compliance with Archdiocesan Youth Ministry Policies. All young adults will room with Chaperones or other young adults.

**Please note that at the time of registration, every group leader will need to create a new username and password, even if the group has attended in the past.

Participant Individual Registration

After the "Group Leader" has registered the group and the initial deposit has been received by our Office, the "Group Leader" will receive a registration link via e-mail. This link will need to be passed on to each participant in order for them to individually register on-line for the event. This generates the registration form and liability form that will need to be turned in during

Bus Information

When reserving spots, please keep in mind that each bus will need to have 52-54 people on board. Groups will be combined with other groups based on size and satellite launch site locations. Groups smaller than 53 should not assume that the entire group will all be on one bus. Due to the nature of trying to assemble arrangements for all 35-40 buses, some mid-size groups may be split onto two buses as a last case scenario.
