There are a few things in the next couple months that parent involvement will be necessary. Please read the list of activities below and let us know where you can help out! Thanks for your support and time.

February: We need a parent or parents willing to plan the Six Flags trip that the 8th grade attend every year. This would involve ordering the tickets, securing transportation, contacting other parents to chaperone, and getting informational letters out about the trip. This is strictly a parent-sponsored trip, however the homeroom teachers will hand out any letters and collect money for the parent in charge. This trip usually takes place on a Saturday in May; a school day may not be used. Mrs. Riney will provide a packet of information to the parent in charge.
