History

The Republic-Monitor's Robert J. Miget Memorial Scholarship is an annual \$250 award made to one Perry County resident who is a graduating senior and who plans to undertake a newspaper-related course of study in college. The candidate should plan to work in journalism, advertising/marketing or design.

The Robert J. Memorial Scholarship was established in 2008 in honor of the late Robert J. Miget, who worked at The Republic-Monitor for 42 years before retiring in 2000 as advertising sales manager.

Qualifications and Instructions

- Applicants must be high school seniors who have exhibited academic achievement and/or economic need.
- Students should be planning to enroll in a full-time course of study leading to a degree with a major in a field related to newspapers.
- Applications must be submitted on the scholarship form or photocopied form. Attachments must include and are limited to an official high school transcript with class rank, GPA and ACT scores; a letter of recommendation; a resume outlining extracurricular activities and an original essay on the subject "What My Community Newspaper Means To Me."
- The scholarship selection is final and binding.
- Applications must be postmarked no earlier than Feb. 1 and no later than April 15.
- Return the completed application and attachments to The Republic-Monitor, PO Box 367, Perryville, MO 63775.
