

COURSE TITLE: SPANISH 2

GRADE LEVEL: 10th Grade

COURSE LENGTH: 2 SEMESTERS

PREREQUISITE: SPA 1

COURSE CREDIT: 1

COURSE GOALS:

1. Students will write short paragraphs on specific topic for further grammar development.
 2. Students will practice speech and pronunciation with short reading, tongue twisters, reading passages, and conversations.
 3. Students will show and produce simple skits related to chapter's topics.
 4. Students will categorize, compare, and practice and identify different tense throughout readings. (Present, past, etc.)
 5. Students will describe and compare Hispanic culture in relation to United States.
 6. Students will read, translate and explain among themselves some target stories.
 7. Students will use the language both within and beyond the school setting. (optional abroad trip)
 8. Students will be assessing on composition and reading fluency.
 9. Students will contrast Hispanic activities to their own.
 10. Students will create small crafts for further learning of culture and traditions.
