

COURSE TITLE: The Revelation of Jesus Christ in Scripture

COURSE LENGTH: 1 semester

COURSE TYPE: required

COURSE CREDIT: 0.5 credit

GRADE LEVEL: 9

PREREQUISITE: n/a

COURSE GOALS:

1. Students will identify Scripture as revelation, the inspired word of God.
 2. Students will distinguish the relation between oral and written tradition and the Canon of Scripture.
 3. Students will relate biblical interpretation to archeology and science, using Church teachings as their guide.
 4. Students will recognize the structure and unity of the Old Testament and the New Testament.
 5. Students will identify the Gospels as central to Christian faith.
 6. Students will apply Scriptural passages in their life and prayer.
 7. Students will identify key scriptural themes from the Old Testament and the New Testament.

COURSE CONTENT:

1. Respect for Scripture as the revealed Word of God
2. Regard for the Gospels as central to the Bible
3. Acceptance in faith of Jesus Christ and his teaching
4. Acceptance that authentic interpretation of Scripture comes through the Church
5. Knowledge of the structure of the Bible and how to locate Scripture passages
6. Definitions of Divine Revelation and Divine Inspiration.
7. Identification of the various literary forms in Scripture
8. Connection of the truths of scripture and faith with science
9. Explanation of persons and events in scripture and their meaning
10. Application of Scripture to life and as guide in decision making
