1. Students will define terms and identify influential individuals and events in the history of the world.
  2. Students will evaluate elements of continuity and change in the social, political, and economic history of the world.
  3. Students will identify the worldwide development of the principles later expressed in documents shaping constitutional democracy in the United States.
  4. Students will analyze elements of geography and their relationships to changes in society and environment throughout history.
  5. Students will use the tools of social studies inquiry in the production of short papers, projects, and demonstrations relative to world history.
