4. Students will explain key doctrinal and ritual differences of other major religions.
5. Students will exhibit a welcoming and inviting attitude toward the people of other religions.
6. Students will compare their Christian service activities to the ideas of St. Vincent.
7. Students will demonstrate a strong devotion to Jesus' call to spread His love and mercy through Christian service.
8. Students will participate in the opportunities they have for Christian service as a way to nurture their faith.

2. Comparison between other religions (Hinduism, Buddhism, Islam) and the Catholic faith.
3. Service for school, parish, and community
4. Service as an opportunity to strengthen relationships with God and others
